DEV 3.1 Modernising/Updating International Offices

- The IRO will be either physically established or modernised. Equipment necessary to carry out its mission will be purchased by the project management group and installed in each IRO.

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DEV 3.2 Project Management Offices

- The PMO will be established in each partner institution and fully equipped with the necessary equipment and infrastructure to assist faculty and staff members of the university in all aspects of management of projects. Ideally PMO can be part of the deanship of scientific research and have the following personnel: director, proposal writing officer, finance and procurement officer and support staff. **30/09/2015**



DEV 4.1 International Projects Management

- A 3-day workshop will be held in YU which shows how to use the databases, write good successful academic projects (Tempus, Framework and Erasmus Mundus), and manage projects both financially and technically. All partner institution international office will attend the workshop. **31/01/2015**

DEV 3.3 Students' Centres Students'

- Centres will be established in each partner institution to support students, conduct training; providing technical assistance to faculty, students, staff, and administrators on diversity issues and encourage international students to take part in university decision making, promote the social role of student societies especially for international students, and train students in "soft skills" which relate to communication, presentational and personal qualities.

DEV 4.3 Students Soft skills and Mobility Exchanges

- A 3-day training workshop will be held in IBNTU on students on soft skills, running successful mobility schemes such as Erasmus Mundus, supporting formation of students' centers and utilising fully alumni societies. One representative from each partner institution international office will attend the workshop. **30/04/2015**



DEV 3.4 Enhancing Virtual Internationalisation

CUAS and PSUT will be technically responsible for the creation, development and running of the open virtual platform. Partner universities will supervise administration matters and coordinate with CUAS & PSUT concerning technical support and development of the platform. EU partners will develop 6 pilot modules, one for each partner university, for enhancing teaching and ensuring the necessary technical conditions for realisation of virtual internationalisation. **30/09/2015**

DEV 4.5 e-Tools Skills development

A 3-day trainings workshop will be held in CUAS to improve e-tools skills of staff and professors and to raise the level of the faculty's readiness to use modern technologies in internationalisation, particularly delivering pilot modules. The workshops will also include distance components involving all the binomial participants from EU. **30/09/2015**



- **DEV 4.2 First Multiplier effect**

The academics who have received the training will be encouraged to offer training to other academics in their institutions on International Projects Management. This will explore all possible avenues for international project funding. It is hoped that this training from this activity will be thus extended to around 100 academics. **31/08/2015**

- **DEV 4.4 Second Multiplier Effect**

The soft skill courses that are developed will be taught at the partner institution to all staff and students who are on mobility courses, and including alumni society staff. This could result in hundreds of students availing themselves of this excellent opportunity. **30/11/2015**





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- **DEV 4.3 Students Soft skills and Mobility Exchanges**

A 3-day training workshop will be held in IBNTU on students on soft skills, running successful mobility schemes such as Erasmus Mundus, supporting formation of students' centers and utilising fully alumni societies. Partner institutions which already have flourishing alumni societies and deliver existing courses will bring their experience to this workshop. One representative from each partner institution international office will attend the workshop.

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EXP 5.1 Selecting ANI Experts

- 20 experts in internationalisation will be selected from partners as well as other institutions in South Neighboring Partner Countries in order to form the core membership of ANI and to carry out its mandate. These experts will be trained by EAIE. **30/06/2015**

EXP 5.2 Preparation of Training Materials

- Training materials will be prepared and customized to the South Neighboring Partner Countries needs to train the experts on how to manage and run ANI. The material will be kept for future use after the end of the project and would be helpful to train further experts. E-training materials are also envisaged. **30/09/2015**
