Agreements	No agreements. Each university offers annually the number of places for the whole network.
Geographical coverage	Latin American countries and Southern European Countries (Spain and Italy)

Fields of studies	Depending on: The project definition The faculties decide about their participation
Agreements	The partnership as a whole decides the mobility flows
Geographical coverage	Middle East, Russia, Central Asia and North America

Level of mobility	Bachelor (In-bound mobility)
Fields of studies	Depending on: Priority areas defined by the Brazilian government. Universities' offer (6 out of 18)
Agreements	Between the Brazilian and the Spanish governments. Between the Spanish government and the participating universities
Geographical coverage	Brazil

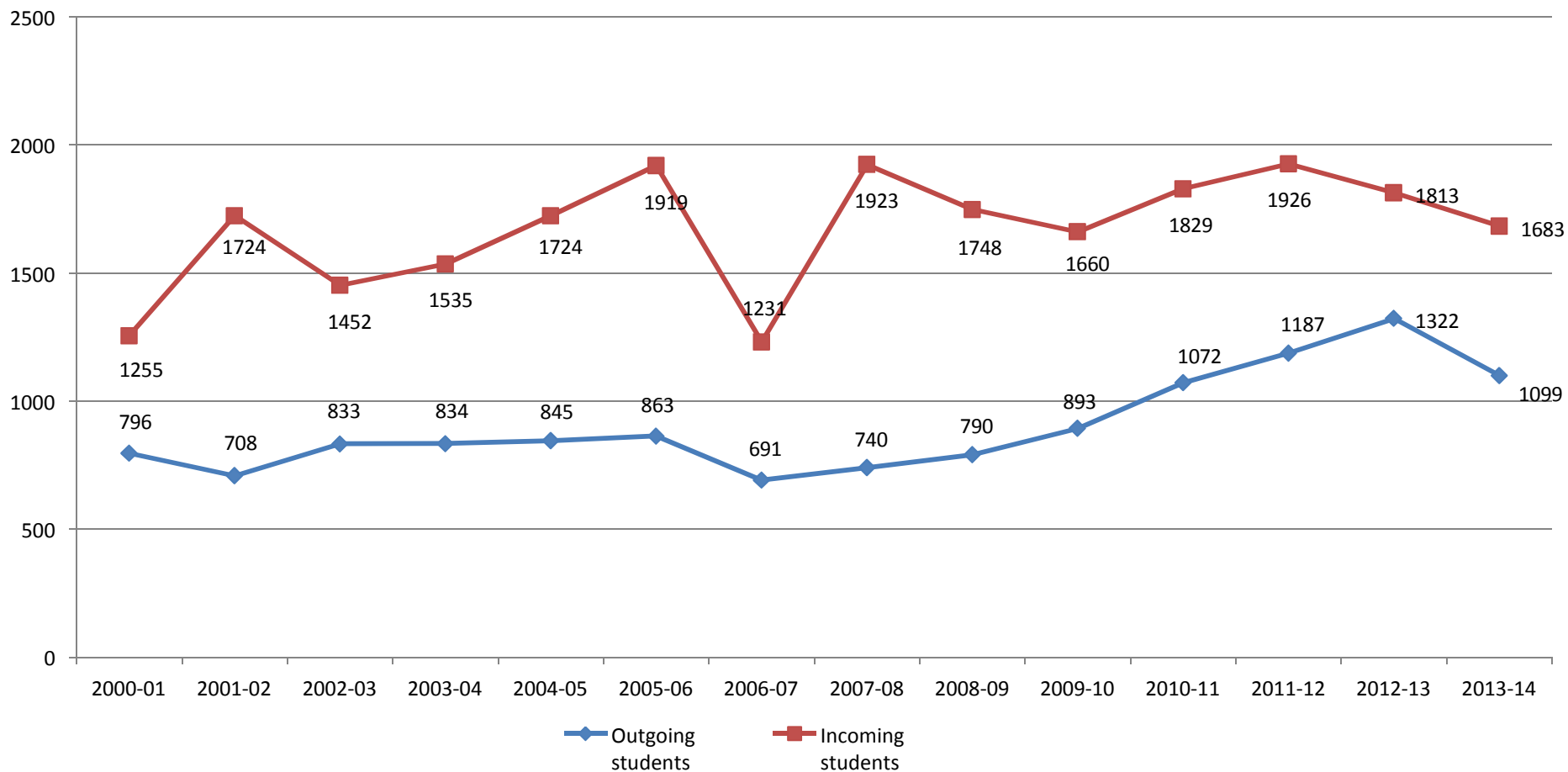
